With reference to the subject cited above, I am directed to inform that proposals are invited from eligible institutions under components 2,3,6,8 and 10 of RUSA 2.0. Further, the proposals will be submitted through an online portal called as "Challenge Level Funding" portal and will remain open up to 18th January, 2019 (till 11.00 PM). Basic guideline regarding the submission proposals is given at Annexure-I and component wise eligibility criteria given at Annexure-II. Apart from that Institutions funded under any component of RUSA 1.0 are not eligible under the same component of RUSA 2.0.

Therefore, you are requested to adhere to the deadline and submit the proposals as per the eligibility criteria given at Annexure-II.

Detail guideline for submission of proposals

Link for submission of proposal :-<http://rusaclf.tiss.edu/#/login>

Basic guidelines:

1. All the institute's need to signup
2. While signing up they need to upload "**Signed Copy Authorization Letter**". On the signup form itself ,the institute can find the "**Download authorization form link**".
3. Once they signup a verification email will be sent on the mentioned email id. User needs to click on the link to get verified.
4. After which they can successfully login to the system using the email id and password.
5. Then under Tab 1 Institute needs to answer the questions.
6. Under Tab2 depending on the answers they will be able to apply for the components.
7. Under Tab3 component specific questions will be asked.
8. Institute can apply for that particular component or just save it and then apply before the deadline.
9. Also, there is **Reset** option which will reset the entire application and the Institute will have to fill all the details again including the questions in Tab1.

N.B. Since the State is to moderate the proposal by 18th January,2019, the eligible Institutions need to complete the process by 17th January,2019 positively.

Component No-2: "Creation of University by way of conversion of colleges in a cluster"

- Colleges fulfilling conditions of autonomy under the UGC Autonomous College Regulations, 2018 of the UGC will be eligible.
- Colleges with high Teacher-Student Ratio, Post –Graduate Departments, and having filled 85% of their sanctioned faculty positions etc. are eligible to be considered

Component No-3: Infrastructure Grants to Universities:

- Universities with valid **NAAC accreditation over 2.5** will be eligible.
- Grant will be provided to support for strengthening of infrastructure facilities for new construction, renovation and purchase of equipment.

Component-06": "Up-gradation of existing degree colleges to Model Degree Colleges" :

- College with NAAC Accreditation of **2.0-2.5 CGPA**.
- Support will be provided to upgrade existing college **in the Aspirational Districts**

Component No-08: "Enhancing Quality and Excellence in select Autonomous Colleges" :

- Autonomous Colleges (**3.51 and above**) which features in UGC's Autonomous College Regulations, 2018 will be eligible for support under this component.

Component No-10

Research, Innovation and Quality Improvement:

- Only Grade I and II State Universities qualifying under the UGC Graded Autonomy Regulations, 2018 will be considered for support.
