Sir.

In inviting a reference to the subject cited above, I am directed to state that, as per the Proceedings of the meeting held on 26.11.2013 under the Chairmanship of the Hon'ble Minister, Finance, P.E.,

"there shall be no grant-in-aid facility for all the new Non-Government

colleges granted opening permission after 30.11.2013."

Accordingly, in the subsequent HPC meetings, it was decided that while giving permission for opening of new college/ stream/ subject/ increase of seats, those colleges/ institutions shall be treated as self-financing colleges/ institutions, i.e., no grant-in-aid shall be provided to those colleges/ institutions.

Hence, whether it is mentioned or not, it is understood that all the colleges/ institutions opened after 30.11.2013 are on self-financing mode. Whenever, any communication is made in this regard without mentioning "self-financing" should be treated as self-financing colleges/ institutions.
