Sub: Relaxation of percentage of marks at Post Graduation Level in Non-Government Aided Colleges notified under GIA Order, 2008.

Sir,

Apropos the subject cited above, I am directed to say that Government after careful consideration have decided to relax the percentage of marks having less than 55% but more than 48% at Post Graduation Level in respect of the Lecturers who were appointed during the period from 08.04.1991 to 10.06.1997(as per list enclosed) of Non-Government Aided Colleges notified under GIA Order, 2008 subject to fulfillment of the following conditions

1. These Lecturers may be asked to undertake in the form of an affidavit to acquire M.Phil/Ph.D Degree within a period of three years.
2. These Lecturers may be asked to undertake in the form of an affidavit not to claim UGC/GIA etc in future
3. Their cases may be considered for approval of block grant under GIA Order, 2008 subject to fulfillment of other conditions as provided in the said GIA Order.
4. If they fail to acquire the higher qualification as stated at (1) above, the block grant so extended in their favour shall be withdrawn/recovered from them forthwith.

You are therefore requested to follow above instruction accordingly.
