**PROCEEDINGS OF THE HIGH POWER COMMITTEE CONSTITUTED VIDE
GOVERNMENT NOTIFICATION NO. 15641/HE., DT. 01.05.2004
HELD ON 13.05.2005 AT 1.30 P.M. AND CONTINUED ON 14.05.2005 AT 11 A.M. IN
THE CONFERENCE HALL OF HIGHER EDUCATION DEPARTMENT**

A meeting of the High Power Committee was held in the Conference hall of the Higher Education Department under the Chairmanship of Commissioner-cum-Secretary to Govt., to consider the applications of general educational agencies and professional educational agencies for grant of permission/recognition, opening of new subject and Hons. course , new streams and increase of seats etc. under section 5 and 6 of the Orissa Education Act, 1969 .

The Commissioner-cum-Secretary to Government, Deptt. of Higher Education, Orissa and Chairman of the Committee desired to know about the details of the proposals received from the RDEs. and Director, Higher Education for consideration of permission/ recognition in respect of general courses and professional courses from various private educational institutions. The Committee members were informed that altogether 177 proposals relating to permission/recognition , opening of new subjects etc including 50 proposals from Sanskrit Colleges have been received in the Deptt. for consideration by the H.P.C. Besides proposals for permanent/temporary recognition in respect of 6 Law Colleges and 32 Professional colleges were also considered. After detailed discussions on the items as per the agenda, the following decisions were taken in favour of different educational institutions and different courses.

1. Opening of New Colleges

Altogether 16 applications were received for permission to open new colleges, out of which 15 were for +2 colleges and 1 was for +3 college recommended by the RDEs. All these applications were considered in detail by the Committee. After taking into consideration the financial viability and educational needs etc, permission was given to 16nos. of general colleges as at **Annexure – 'A'** . This permission was granted, subject to condition that the educational agencies shall pledge an amount of Rs. 5.00 lakh before the Prescribed Authority and further amount of Rs. 20.00 lakh shall be deposited in shape of fixed deposit within a period of one month from the date of grant of permission, failing which the educational agency shall not be permitted to admit the students. Further the Secretaries of the Governing Bodies should furnish an undertaking in the form of an affidavit that they will not claim any financial assistance or grant-in-aid from Govt. in future.

2. Permanent Recognition to +2 and +3 general colleges

The Deptt. had received a total of 4nos. of proposals from RDEs for permanent recognition i.e. 2 for +2 and 2 for +3 colleges. After detailed examination and discussions made in this regard, permanent recognition was granted in favour of two colleges. One proposal was

rejected and other one was deferred for the next meeting. The list of such colleges accorded recognition is placed at **Annexure –‘B’**.

3. **Permanent Recognition to Sanskrit Colleges.**

Altogether 50 proposals from Sanskrit Colleges were received from RDEs, out of which 5 proposals relate to permission to present students in the annual examination. As these are very routine cases and not the subject matter of HPC, it was decided not to take up this matter in the meeting. Out of the rest 45 proposals 42 were considered in detail and it was decided to accord permanent recognition in favour of 42 such Sanskrit Colleges as per Annexure –‘C’. 3nos. of proposals were deferred for consideration after due compliance relating to alienation of land.

4. **Temporary Recognition.**

All five proposals for grant of temporary recognition for four +2 colleges and one +3 college received from RDEs were considered in detail and the Committee decided to accord temporary recognition in favour to the all five as per the list at **Annexure- ‘D’**.

5. **Increase of seats in +2 and +3 Colleges.**

Proposals for increase of seats of two +2 colleges and increase of seats in respect of nineteen +3 colleges have been received from the RDEs for consideration. After detailed discussion the Committee decided to allow increase of seats under different subjects/streams as per details mentioned against such colleges as in the list at **Annexure – ‘E’**.

6. **Opening of Honours Subjects in +3 Colleges.**

Proposals for opening of Hons. in specific subjects from 48 +3 colleges were received through RDEs for consideration. After detailed discussions, the Committee decided to allow opening of Hons. in the subjects taking into account the sanctioned strength, availability of qualified teachers and other relevant parameters. The list of colleges allowed opening of Hons. in specific subjects is at **Annexure –‘ F’**.

7. Opening of New Subjects in +2 and +3 Colleges

A total of 25 proposals including 11 for +2 and 14 for +3 colleges have been received from RDEs. In respect of proposals received from fourteen +3 colleges, the Committee decided that since the matter relating to rationalization proposal is pending for finalisation the matter should be deferred. The proposals for opening of new subjects in eleven +2 colleges with specific number of seats to be allowed against each such subject were considered. The approved list of these is at Annexure – 'G'.

8. Opening of New Stream in +2 and +3 Colleges.

Eight proposals for opening of new streams including 4 for +2 and 4 for +3 colleges received from RDEs were taken up for consideration. The Committee after discussion decided to accord permission to open new streams with number of seats specified against each in respect of the colleges as at Annexure- 'H'.

9. Permission/ Recognition of Law Colleges

Proposals in respect of six private law colleges including one proposal for opening permission, three for permanent recognition and two for temporary recognition were received from Director Higher Education. After detailed discussions proposals of two such colleges i.e. Kalinga Law College, Bhubaneswar and Bhadrak Law College, Bhadrak for permanent recognition and renewal of temporary recognition respectively were rejected on grounds of inadequate infrastructure and as more than 11 years have elapsed in case of Bhadrak Law College since inception and renewal of temporary recognition was not possible any further. The proposal for grant of permanent recognition for 3 year LL.B. Course with restricted student strength of 160 seats was allowed in favour of Dhenkanal Law College, Dhenkanal in line with recommendation of Justice Mohapatra Committee. The proposal of Athagarh Law College, Athagarh for permanent recognition of 3 year LL.B. course with 80 seats was approved subject to submission of ROR (patta) in the name of the institution within a period of 3 months. One proposal relating to opening permission applied for by Indian Institute of Law, Mancheswar, Bhubaneswar was deferred due to deficiency in enquiry report and DHE was instructed to conduct enquiry in respect of this proposal and submit his enquiry

report for consideration in the next meeting. The proposal for renewal of temporary recognition of Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Law College, Dharmagarh, Kalahandi was allowed by the Committee.

10. Permission/ Recognition and Increase of seats in Professional Colleges

Altogether 32 proposals were received from Director Higher Education in respect of private professional colleges out of which 14 proposals relate to opening permission, 3 proposals for grant of permanent recognition, 13 relate to temporary recognition and rest 2 relate to increase of seats. The Committee after detailed discussions allowed opening permission in respect of all such 13 colleges with restriction on student strength, subject to fulfillment of the required condition like pledging of Rs. 5.00 lakh to the Prescribed Authority and a further deposit of Rs. 20.00 lakh in shape of fixed deposit within a period of one month from the date of grant of permission, failing which the educational agency shall not be permitted to admit the students. Out of three proposals received under permanent recognition, one proposal was allowed in favour of Raghunath Jew School of Management Studies, Balasore and other two proposals were deferred with instructions that these two proposals should be inspected by the DHE / RDEs and the inspection report submitted to the Govt. for placement in the next HPC meeting. Out of rest 14 proposals relating to temporary recognition, two proposals were allowed by the Committee and rest 12 proposals were deferred for next HPC meeting after detailed enquiry and submission of reports by DHE /RDEs concerned. Out of rest two proposals relating to increase of seats, one was deferred for submission after due inspection by DHE, in the next meeting and the other one was rejected. The details of proposals allowed with nos. of seats /deferred /rejected are placed at Annexure- 'I'.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks to chair.






