A counter affiliavit has been filed by andicated berein above. the Deputy Director, Higher Education, NGC-I, On the on behalf of O. . No. 2-Director of Higher Education, Orissa, indicating therein that the scheme of revision of pay scales of University and College Teachers formulated by the University Grants Commission for implementation with effect from 1.1. 1986 was communicated to the State Government by letter dated 17.6.1987 with subsequent clarification on 7.9.1987 and 22.7.1988 Vide Annex res-A/2, B/2 and C/2 respectively. In Annexdre-A/2, i.e., the letter dated 17.6.1987, according to the learned counsel for the O.Ps., it was left to the State Government to adopt and implement the scheme into consideration and also to decide in their discretion to introduce scales of pay different from those mentioned in the scheme and may also give effect to the revised scales of pay from 1.1.1986 or on a later date. According to the learned counsel for the O.Ps., in order to extend the revised U.G. . scales of pay to bona fide teachers, the Government in Education and Youth . Services Department | vide resolution 19.44032 dated 6.10.198b (Annexure-D/2) decided

The sum and substance of the argument of The learned counsel for O.P.No.2 is that as the petitioner was appointed on 25.10.1991, i.e., after 1.4.1989, he is not entitled to get the benefit as envisaged under the said scheme. Further, it is stated that the U.G.C. scales of pay are only applicable to the teachers of Degree Colleges and not to the teachers of educational institutions imparting +2 courses, which does not come under the purview of U.G.C. and, therefore, the U.G.C. scales can have no application to them. as the petitioner joined for the first time in Christ College, Cuttack and his appointment was approved with effect from 25.10.1991 under the direct payment scheme which is after 1.4.1989, he is not entitled to

Now the question arises whether the petitioner was appointed in a Degree College or a College imparting |+2 education. We have already stated in the foregoing paragraph that the advertisement in response to which the petitioner submitted his application and faced the interview does not show anything to come to a conclusion that the petitioner was appointed in an institution importing +2 education and secondly the petitioner was appointed against post of Botany, which was created and approved as per Annexuse-6, i.e., on 26.2.1979. It is, therefore, evident that the post against which the petitioner was appointed in Christ college was covered under the direct payment scheme with effect from the academic session 1984-1985 and as such the petitioner comes within the sweep of 'Coverage' envisaged in papalgraph 3.1 of the resolution dated 6.10.1989, the relevant portion of which is quoted in the preceding paragraph.

6. This being the fact, we are not in a position to find any ground to deny the benefit as claimed by the petitioner. The ground of such denial, as taken by O.P No.2 in his
