yard-stick for teaching posts in covernment and non-Government Colleges of the State

Sir

In supersession of G.O. No. 35897/EYS., dt. 4.9.81, I am directed to say that, after careful consideration, Government have been pleased to fix the yard-stick for creation of teaching posts in Government and non-Government Colleges of the State with effect from the second academic session, 1983-84 as follows:-

- (i) To assess the work-load, a college should be taken as the unit for each subject;
- (ii) Each tutorial/practical group for Arts/Science/ Commerce subject should consist of 24 students for Intermediate and | 2 course;
- (iii) In the degree/post-graduate stage, the existing tutorial/practical group, wherever necessary, would comprise of 16 students as at present;
- (iv) Six periods for Honours/ P.G. Classes are to be seven periods for Pass Classes;
- (v) The work-load for a teacher should be 25 (twenty-five) periods a week of six working days;

- to be taken) according to the routine and student strength on the roll of the college in the working days during the period between August and Februtaken into account for the purpose of assessment.
- (vii) When the total work-load computed on the afore-said basis exceeds any multiple of 25 per week by will be sanctioned for the fractional excess.
- 2. For the year, 1983-84, the assessment of work-load for +2 classes has, however, to be estimated on the basis of a reasonable projected work-load.
- 3. I am, therefore, to request you kindly to adopt the above yard-stick and femish necessary proposal to accordingly.
- 4. Principals of all Government and non-Government colleges are being informed.
