The proceedings of the last meeting of HPC held on 06.12.2006 and 11.12.2006 was confirmed by the members of the Committee.

The Commissioner-cum-Secretary to Govt. Department of Higher Education and the Chairman of the Committee initiating the discussion intimated that 41 proposals from RDEs

and DHE relating to permission/recognition in favour of general and professional colleges have been received in the Department. After detailed discussion, the following decisions were taken.

2. Permanent recognition to +2 and +3 colleges

The Department has received a total of 14 proposals for grant of permanent recognition, out of which 7 are for +2 and 7 are for +3 colleges. After detailed discussion held in this regard, the committee decided to allow permanent recognition in respect of one +2 college and other six cases were deferred indicating reasons against each of the college. Out of seven +3 colleges, the committee allowed permanent recognition in respect of two colleges and rest five cases were deferred indicating reasons against each of the college. The list of the colleges allowed/deferred is at Annexure-A.

During discussion it was observed that the RDEs and DHE are not coming prepared with relevant information. It was decided that the RDEs and DHE shall come with information relating to permission / 1st recognition/subsequent renewal of recognition upto 7th year, enrollment, appearance and results of examination till date, availability of qualified teaching faculty, availability of various infrastructure as per the Act, constitution of Governing Body as per relevant rules, Video C.D. etc. *They cannot take the plea that their predecessors had recommended the cases.* The decision of last HPC meeting was held on 06.12.2006 and 11.12.2006 regarding joint committee inspection to colleges for temporary and permanent recognition is modified and it is decided that the joint committee will inspect in case of temporary recognition from 5th year and for permanent recognition cases.

3. Temporary Recognition to +2 and +3 Colleges

Altogether 6 proposals out of which 5 for +2 and one for +3 college have been received from Regional Directors for grant of temporary recognition. After detailed discussion, the committee decided to accord temporary recognition in respect of one +2 college and rest 4 proposals were deferred indicating ^{reasons} against each. Proposal of one +3 college for grant of temporary recognition was allowed by the committee. The list of cases allowed/deferred is placed at Annexure-B.

4. Opening of New Subject

Proposal for opening of new subject in respect of Women's College, Bargarh was received from RDE, Samablapur. After discussion it was decided to defer the case with instruction to RDE, Samablapur to submit detailed information.

5. Increase of seats

Proposal for increase of seats in respect of Rairakhol Women's College, Rairakhol was received from RDE, Sambalpur. After discussion held in this regard, the committee decided to defer the case with instruction to RDE, Sambalpur to furnish the detailed information.


6. Professional Colleges

All together 17 proposals were received from DHE in respect of private professional institutions. The committee after detailed discussion decided to allow 9 proposals and other 8 proposals were deferred. The list of cases allowed/deferred is placed at Annexure-C.

The proposal for grant of permanent recognition in favour of Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Law College, Dharmagarh, Kalahandi was discussed and the committee decided to defer the case with instruction to DHE to furnish complete information as required under the Act.

7. General

It was observed that the RDE, Bhubaneswar has communicated the decision of High Power Committee to concern colleges. But it was observed in the meeting that the final decision taken in the matter may be communicated to the concerned college for implementation, but discussion/information regarding movement of files etc. in the Deptt. may not be communicated to subordinate offices, since it goes against the official decorum.
