**PROCEEDINGS OF THE HIGH POWER COMMITTEE CONSTITUTED
VIA GOVERNMENT NOTIFICATION NO. 27232/H.E.; Dtd. 27.05.2002 HELD
ON 28.07.2004 AT 11.30 A.M. IN THE CONFERENCE HALL OF
HIGHER EDUCATION DEPARTMENT.**

The meeting of the High Power Committee was held in the Conference Hall of the Higher Education Department under the Chairmanship of Commissioner-cum-Secretary to consider the application of general educational agencies for grant of permission / recognition, opening of new subjects and honors course, new streams and increase of seats etc.

1. **Opening of New Colleges:**

These applications were considered and taking into consideration the financial viability and educational need, permission was given to 4 no. of colleges as at Annexure-'A' subject to conditions mentioned against each. The secretaries on behalf of the G.E. as well as all the employees should furnish an undertaking in the form of an affidavit that they will not claim any financial assistance or GRANT-IN-AID from Govt. in future. The cases of Shree Baladev Jew Mahila Mahavidyalaya, Buguda, N.A.C., Ganjam and Model College for Women, Ganjam were rejected.

2. **Renewal of Temporary Recognition of +3 Degree Colleges and +2 Junior Colleges:**

The proposals received from Regional Director of Education, Berhampur for renewal of temporary recognition of +3 Degree College and +2 Junior

Colleges, were not considered for want of information regarding land, infrastructure and other pre-requisites. The power delegated to the Regional Directors for grant of temporary recognition is withdrawn. Henceforth, they should submit proposals to the Government in the prescribed format giving detail information for consideration of the H.P.C. Once temporary/ permanent recognition is accorded to a private educational institution, it should be deemed to be temporary/permanent recognition for new subjects, honors subjects, new streams and increase of seats permitted to the said institutions subsequent to initial permission to open the college.

3. Permanent Recognition to +3 Colleges:

Proposals received from the R.D.E., Sambalpur in respect of 11 colleges, after due consideration, permanent recognition was accorded as at Annexure-'B' w.e.f. the session and subject to the conditions stipulated against each regarding acquisition of land, library books and construction of additional rooms.

4. Permanent Recognition to +2 Colleges;

Altogether, 114 proposals of proposals were received from the R.D.E., Berhampur, Sambalpur & Bhubaneswar. The proposals were considered and permanent recognition was accorded from the session 2004-2005 subject to the conditions indicated against each as at Annexure-'C' as regards acquisition of land, library books, additional rooms and rationalization of excess staff.

ii) Grant of permanent recognition to the following colleges was deferred.

- a) Maharishi College of Natuaral Law, (Day shift) BBSR, Khurda.
- b) Maharishi College of Natuaral Law, (Morning shift) BBSR, Khurda.

The R.D.E., Bhubaneswar was requested to conduct an inquiry as to why 2 colleges in the same name, in the same premises are existing showing Morning Shift & Day Shift. On receipt of the report from the R.D.E., Bhubaneswar, their cases will be considered in the next meeting of the H.P.C.

5. Permission for opening of Honors subjects in +3 Degree Colleges:

The proposals submitted by the Regional Directors were considered and only where opening of Honors subject was considered most viable, it was allowed on specific recommendation of the concerned Regional Directors. The name of the colleges alongwith the Honors subjects allowed with number of seats and conditions is at Annexure-'D'. Opening of Honors subjects was discouraged in other private aided colleges because it would entail appointment of fresh lecturers and there would be demand for Grant-in-Aid in future. Accordingly, it was considered that indiscriminate grant of permission for opening of Honors subject would lead to future financial liability for the State.

6. Permission for opening new subjects in +2 & +3 Colleges:

The proposal of R.D.E., Bhubaneswar for Royal College of Science & Technology, BBSR, Khurda was allowed with new subjects i.e. I.T. Electronics and Bio-Technology in +2 Science Stream with 32 seats each. Permission for opening of new subjects to the following +2 colleges was rejected, as it would entail future financial liability and claimer for Grant-in-Aid for additional teaching posts.

The Director was requested to obtain the opinion of University whether courses like M.A. in Human Lives, Disaster Preparedness Management, Rural Development, Social Medicine and Public Health should be allowed to private educational institutions and whether such courses have any future prospect.

7. Permission for opening of new stream, new Elective & Vocational Subjects to +2 & +3 Colleges:

The proposals submitted by the R.D.E., Bhubaneswar for 2 no. of +2 Colleges and 10 no. of +3 Colleges for opening of new streams were considered & rejected as this would entail recruitment of additional lecturers with the potentiality of future financial liability for the State.

As regards the proposal of the Regional Director, Sambalpur opening permission to minor elective subject Indian Economy with B.P. Degree College, Sonepur was rejected on the ground that one of subject of existing optional subject should be allowed as minor elective Subject Economics has not been allowed to the College as an optional proposal of R.D.E., Sambalpur for opening following vocational Larambha college was allowed with 30 seats each with the condition should run on self-financing basis till the U.G.C. grant is exhausted. As the students desire, then, the same courses may run on self-financing any case, Govt. will not bear any financial liability in future. The Director will intimate the Government about the stipulation given by the while giving grant-in-aid to the college for opening vocational subjects.
