PROCEEDINGS OF THE HIGH POWER COMMITTEE MEETING CONSTITUTED VIDE GOVERNMENT NOTIFICATION NO.15641/HE, DATED 01.05.2004 HELD ON 30.X.2006 AT 11. 00 A.M. IN THE CONFERENCE HALL OF HIGHER EDUCATION DEPARTMENT.

1. A meeting of the High Power Committee constituted vide Government Notification No.15641/HE dated 01.05.2004 was held in the Conference Hall of the Higher Education Department under the Chairmanship of Commissioner-cum-Secretary to consider the proposals for grant of permission/recognition, increase of seats, opening of new stream/new subjects etc. under section-5 and 6 of the Orissa Education Act, 1969. The Commissioner-cum-Secretary to Government, Department of Higher Education, Orissa and Chairman of the Committee desired to know about the details of proposals received from the Regional Directors of Education and Director, Higher Education for consideration of permission/recognition in respect of general and professional courses from various private



educational institutions. The Committee members were informed that altogether 88 proposals relating to permission/recognition of general colleges and professional colleges which were deferred in the last High Power Committee meeting including fresh proposals were included in the item for consideration.


2. After threadbare discussion the Committee decided to defer all 88 proposals due to want of complete information in support of different colleges. The Director, Higher Education and Regional Directors of Education are instructed to furnish complete information and Video C.D. in respect of proposals as per decision held in the High Power Committee meeting held on 16.09.2006 and 27.09.2006 and come prepared after watching the videos themselves.

3. The decision of High Power Committee meeting held on 16.09.2006 allowing increase of seats from 256 seats to 512 seats in +2 Science of Kalinga Bharati Residential College, Cuttack was modified and increase of seats from 256 to 416 seats was allowed from the session 2006-07.

✓ Besides increase of seats from 64 to 96 in +3 Arts in respect of Women's College, Paralakhemundi, Dist. Gajapati was allowed from the Session-2006-07 in addition to increase of seats in individual subjects as per the decision of the of the High Power Committee meeting held on 27.09.2006. The High Power Committee meeting held on 27.09.2006 granted temporary recognition for the session 2004-05 in favour of J.P. Sandhya Degree Mahavidyalaya, Bhawanipatana, Kalahandi with instruction to submit further information for grant of recognition for the session 2004-05. But the RDE, Sambalpur stated that, Permanent Recognition has already been granted in favour of the aforesaid college from the session 2005-06 vide HPC meeting held on 06.05.2006. Hence, no further information is required to be submitted by RDE, Sambalpur. ✓ The decision of High Power Committee meeting held on 16.09.2006 for withdrawal of recognition in respect of S.B. Science College, Kanshi, Ganjam was amended and recognition was withdrawn from the session 2007-08.

4. **General:**

- (i) During the discussion the Chairman of the Committee stated that all members of the committee are supposed to put their signature on the proceedings recorded after the meeting. But it is seen that none of the members are putting their signature on the proceedings and the same is endorsed to him for his approval. All the




members were requested to put their signature on the proceedings henceforth, after which the same will be submitted to Chairman for his approval.

- (ii) It was also observed by Chairman of the committee that as per Section 4(1) of O.E. Rule, 1991, "if any Educational Agency desirous of establishing a new college in the state in a particular year shall make an application to the Director/Regional Director of Education between 1st day of October and 30th day of November of the year immediately preceding that particular year. Similarly as per provision of Section 6(1) of O.E. Act, 1969, a private educational institution shall make an application for recognition to the prescribed authority on or before the 30th Nov of the academic year in which the institutions starts functioning.

But it seen that most of the colleges are not sticking to the above datelines and are submitting applications almost throughout the year. To streamline the system the committee resolved that henceforth no applications shall be received after stipulation period for grant of permission and recognition. Hence, the committee decided that the Director, Higher Education and Regional Directorate of Education shall issue a Press Note notifying the date line for applying for permission and recognition in respect of Professional Colleges and General Colleges respectively.

- (iii) The Committee further decided that all self-financing colleges (general & professional colleges) should come under ^a Separate Act in order to avoid discrimination while granting permission. ~~So all Regional Directors of Education and Director, Higher Education are instructed to furnish the list of self financing colleges (general and professional) indicating year of permission and courses allowed with sanctioned strength and furnish their views in the matter.~~
