PROCEEDINGS OF THE HIGH POWER COMMITTEE MEETING CONSTITUTED VIDE GOVT. NOTIFICATION No. 15641/HE,Dt. 01.05.2004 HELD ON 31.01.2007 AT 03.00 P.M. IN THE CONFERENCE HALL OF THE HIGHER EDUCATION DEPARTMENT.

1. A meeting of the High Power Committee constituted vide Govt. Notification No.15461/HE dt 01.05.2004 was held in the Conference Hall of the Higher Education Deptt. under the Chairmanship of Commissioner-cum-Secretary , to consider the cases of emergency in nature relating to permission/recognition both in temporary and permanent cases where the appearance of students in the examination are involved for which students are facing problem to appear in the ensuing examination. The Commissioner-cum-Secretary to Government, Department of Higher Education and the Chairman of the Committee initiating the discussion intimated that 23 proposals from R.D.Es relating to permission /recognition where the appearance of students in the examination are involved have been

received in the Department. After detailed discussion, the following decisions were taken.

Permanent recognition to +2 and +3 Colleges.

This Department had received a total number of 7 proposals for grant of permanent recognition, out of which 1 for (+2) colleges and 6 for (+3) colleges. After detailed discussion held in this regard, the committee decided to reject permanent recognition of one +2 college indicating reasons against the name of the college. Out of six +3 Colleges, the Committee allowed permanent recognition in respect of three colleges and rest three cases were rejected indicating reasons against each of the college. The list of the colleges allowed/rejected is at **Annexure-A**.

3. Temporary recognition to +2 and +3 colleges.

Altogether, 7 proposals out of which 3 for (+2) and 4 for (+3) colleges have been received from R.D.Es for grant of temporary recognition.

After detailed discussion, the Committee decided to accord temporary recognition in respect of 3 (+2) colleges and 4 for (+3) colleges. The list of colleges allowed is placed at Annexure-B.

4. Permanent recognition to Sanskrit Colleges.

Altogether 9 proposals have been received from R.D.Es for grant of permanent recognition to Sanskrit colleges. After detailed discussion held in this regard the committee decided to accord renewal of temporary recognition in respect of 8 Sanskrit colleges and rest 1 proposal was deferred. The list of colleges allowed/deferred is placed at **Annexure-C.**
