Online Application for Spot Selection and Admission
to B.Ed. course 2021-2023 against vacant seats

The Online Application for spot selection and admission to B.Ed. course for the session 2021-2023 shall be available in the SAMs portal i.e. samsodisha.gov.in from 06.01.2022 to 12.01.2022.

The detailed procedure for filling up of the vacant seats through spot selection /admission is available in the above website along with the category wise and course wise cut-off marks , vacancy position in different institutions and timeline for spot selection. The students who are already admitted in the institution and desire to be transferred and the students who had appeared the Online Entrance Examination and having the equated scores on and above the cut-off marks are eligible to apply for spot selection/ admission.

All other conditions remain same as per the Information Brochure.

**PROCEDURE OF SPOT SELECTION AND ADMISSION OF THE CANDIDATES IN B.Ed. COURSE DURING
THE SESSION 2021-2023 AGAINST THE VACANT SEATS**

The admission to the B.Ed. and B.H.Ed. course for the session 2021-2023 has been done through SAMS portal. The admission has been made based on the merit list by taking the equated scores of the CBT. After the third phase admission and transfer of the candidates through slide-up process, it is found that there are still some vacancies in some institution in different categories.

In order to fill-up the vacant seats, it has been decided to invite online application from the following categories of eligible candidates:

- Candidates who are already admitted but are willing to go on transfer to the institution where the vacancy is prevailing
- Candidates who have appeared the CBT and in the provisional merit panel, but not selected

Procedure for Spot Selection:

- Advertisement for spot selection shall be published in two odia dailies. The spot admission procedure as well as the institution wise vacancy position (Stream wise and social category wise) will be made available in the SAMs website and department website.
- SMS shall be sent to the candidates in ten (10) times of the vacant seats each against the social and subject category wise vacancy for submission of online application.
- The details of spot admission shall be made available in the notice boards of the institution in order to enable the already admitted candidates to apply for spot selection.
- The candidates are required to give choice for institution having vacant seats as per his/her social category and stream in order of preference (at least 1 or more than that).
- One week (7 days) time shall be given for submission of online application in SAMs portal.

Selection Procedure for Spot Admission:

- After the last date of submission of online application on SAMs portal is over, the institution wise applicant list (Stream wise and Category wise) will be displayed in SAMs portal arranged in order of merit.
- The details of spot selection and institution wise provisional placement list can be viewed by the applicants in the website as well as by the institution Heads in the respective login. The applicants as per their choice option may view their status in the website.
- All the selected applicants for spot selection and admission are required to report in the concerned institution, as per their provisional selection by 1.00pm on the scheduled date with all required original documents and admission fees.
- After the scheduled time for reporting, no one else shall be entertained. The institution shall facilitate the selection by taking into consideration the candidates who have reported in due time. The merit list shall be prepared by the institution against the respective social and subject wise vacancies available from among the students who have reported.
- In case of absence or unwillingness of the candidate or non-eligibility of the selected candidate, the next candidate present in order of merit shall be given preference to take admission.

- The already admitted candidates are required to show the original identity card and money receipt in support of their admission in the previous institution and submit a copy of the same. On receipt of this document, the Head of the Institution shall write to the previous Head of the Institution for sending the Transfer Certificates (TC) on submission of which the admission can be regularised.
- The fresh applicant can take spot admission on the basis of his/her merit by submitting the original documents for verification followed by submission of admission fees as mentioned in the Information Brochure.
- If no candidate is available against the vacant Ex-Serviceman seat, the seat will be deserved and added to the unreserved category. The said seat will be filled up on the basis of merit from among the candidate who have reported for spot selection.
- If SC/ ST candidates are not available in their respective subject categories, the vacant seat shall be added to the other subject category for selection of the candidate. But if no SC/ST candidates are available in any subject category i.e. in Arts or Science, the said seat shall be deserved and added to the unreserved category In the said category and vice-versa.
- In case of non-availability of eligible candidates against any specific earmarked vacant seat, there will be no further admission to fill-up the vacancy, treating there by the seat as a vacant one.
