- III. Centres are requested to prepare financial statements subject-wise/ sitting-wise/ date-wise with the number of candidates allotted in that subject in the top of the statement in order to facilitate the process of scrutinization.
- IV. Each statement shall be signed by the Chairman, P.G. Council as well as CoEs in case of Universities and Principals in case of Govt. Autonomous Colleges.

- V. Scanned copy of bills, vouchers, honorarium/remuneration statements etc. shall be sent to Controller of Examinations, Berhampur University by e-mail controller@buodisha.adu.in with cc to cpetodisha@gmail.com after completion of examination without any delay. After that, it will be scrutinized by CoE, Berhampur University and submitted to Vice-Chairperson, Odisha State Higher Education Council for vetting. The same will be sent to the government for approval.
- VI. The balance amount if any (i.e. Total Expenditure Advance amount) will be paid only after the submission of final bills and necessary approval.

After the examination they have to produce utilisation certificates, Bills & Vouchers to this effect. including hiring of staff where necessary with justification with the same remuneration for Ministerial staff and Menial staff as above Council of all affiliated Universities and Rs. 10,000 for Principal of Autonomous colleges to meet any exigencies and incidental charges, Apart from the above honorarium to different office bearers, an amount of Rs. 25,000 be placed under the disposal of Chairperson, PG

NB- 1. Where there is no PG teaching department for a concerned subject of examination, the Chairperson, PG Council can appoint any senior faculty member for the purpose. In case of exigency, Principals of Autonomous Colleges can authorize a teaching faculty of their choice in place of CoE, to be in-charge of Deputy Superintendent.
