Sub: Guidelines & dateline for PG Vacant Seat Admission (Special SPOT) Selection and Admission under project SAMS for the Academic Session 2021-22

Madam/Sir,

In inviting a reference to the subject cited above, I am directed to inform you that the admission for PG Special SPOT selection and Admission under SMAS will be held as per the guidelines mentioned below:

- 1. Entrance Subject wise Students' Master List (students, those who have qualified CPET Examination-2021 and not taken admission anywhere during 1st and 2nd selection, Spot-I and Spot-II rounds) shall be prepared by SAMS and made available to Universities/Colleges by 11/01/21(02.00PM). Those were issued intimation letters in previous phases, but not taken admission will not be considered in this phase.
- 2. University/College will contact the students from the Master List (Subject wise) and admit them accordingly.
- If students from Master List are not available, then the University/College
 can admit students from the OJEE merit list/National Level Entrance Test or
 any equivalent Test conducted by National Agency by inviting applications at
 their level.
- 4. Once a candidate takes admission in this phase, s/he cannot take ULC/CLC to admit elsewhere during this phase. That means, there is no slide up or slide across provision in this phase.

- 5. There is no reservation or weightage option. Admission will be purely based on merit.
- 6. Submission of admission fees will be in offline mode.
- 7. The admission and data updation should be completed by 25/01/2022 positively. Modus operandi for updation of admission data will be circulated separately.
- 8. COVID-19 appropriate behavior is to be followed strictly while admitting the students.

Therefore, you are requested to complete the above mentioned activities in the stipulated date & time.
