Sub : Decision regarding payment of G.I.A. to the staff appointed against the Degree classes work-load.

I am directed to invite a reference to your letter No. 711 dated 2.2.89 on the subject mentioned above and to say that after careful consideration Government have decided as follows :

- (i) (a) 24, 56 and 46 colleges may receive G.I.A. for 1988-89 at the minimum rate i.e. 1/3rd of salary with effect from 1.6.88 although women colleges and colleges in the backward areas may be eligible for arrears or even 2/3rd. Additional, liability for Honours not to be entertained. As regards retrospective affiliation by the University a liberal view may be taken, since in most cases affiliation was decided upon in due time but was communicated to the colleges 2/3 years later.
 - (b) Their services may be counted for the purpose of seniority with effect from the year of affiliation/concurrence whichever is earlier.
 - (c) Recognition is deemed to have been extended with effect from 1983-84 if not earlier already granted. This is to admit them for G.I.A. as per. O.E. Act.
 - (d) If cases are left over, after scrutiny under orders of Government G.I.A. could be granted for current year subject to availability of funds.
- (ii) (a) Under-qualified persons could be granted G.I.A. for current year first and if funds permit for 87-88 as they have defaulted in not submitting papers.
 - (b). Cases upto 31.12.84 may be brought under G.I.A. only after Government order is issued subject to production of necessary document.
- (iii) No college (aid and unaided) should be allowed G.I.A. for introduction of +2 courses.
- (iv) All those where concurrence has been granted but no G.I.A. mentioned in the order may be allowed G.I.A. in the above categories only.
- (v) Minimum Non-Teaching Staff be allowed G.I.A. on the basis of strength and keeping yardstick in view.
