**Sub. : Payment of grants-in-aid to Non-Govt. Women's Colleges**

In partial modification G.O. No. 11905-EYS, dated 9.3.89 and G.O. No. 5540/EYS, dated 2.2.90, I am directed to say that Govt. after careful consideration have been pleased to decide that the Non-Govt. Women's Colleges which were already in receipt of grants-in-aid in the same principle i.e. after 3, 5 and 7 years for the additional staff admissible on account of direct affiliation by the concerned University or Temporary concurrence granted by State Govt. at degree stage or for increase of seats, opening of new subjects and streams at the old intermediate stage or old degree stage.

It has also been decided that grant-in-aid in respect of those additional staff generate on account of increased work-load for such direct affiliation and temporary concurrence shall be paid only from 1-6-88 notwithstanding the eligibility of such posts for such grant from earlier dates. However, posts manuring for grant as per 3, 5 & 7 years formula shall be notionally calculated and grants shall be paid form 1.6.88 and computing their salaries from their usual date of eligibility.

It is further clarified that this decision of Government shall not apply to the women's colleges coming within the category of 24 temporary concurrence and 57 directly affiliated old Intermediate Colleges.
