Sub: Age of superannuation of teaching and non-teaching employees of Aided Colleges

As per provisions of existing rules, teaching and non-teaching employees of Aided Non-Government Colleges, coming under administrative control of Higher Education Department, superannuate on completion of 60 years of age. Some employees of some of these Colleges had filed writ petitions in the Hon'ble High Court of Odisha praying that they should superannuate on completion of 65 years of age as per UGC Regulations and also as per the system prevailing in Higher Education Institutions of Central Government and some other State Governments.

After detailed hearing, the Hon'ble High Court has dismissed all these writ petitions vide its order dated 20.04.2022 in WP(C) No.13666 of 2020 filed by Dr. Asit Kumar Jenamani. Therefore, the superannuation age of teaching and non-teaching employees of Aided Non-Government Colleges of Odisha remains unchanged, i.e. they will superannuate on completion of 60 years of age.

This is for information of all concerned. Employees of these Colleges are hereby advised not to resort to litigations in this matter by wasting their hard-earned money.
